CARBON REDUCTION PLAN GUIDANCE

Notes for Completion

Where an In-Scope Organisation has determined that the measure applies to the procurement, suppliers wishing to bid for that contract are required at the selection stage to submit a Carbon Reduction Plan which details their organisational carbon footprint and confirms their commitment to achieving Net Zero by 2050.

Carbon Reduction Plans are to be completed by the bidding supplier¹ and must meet the reporting requirements set out in supporting guidance, and include the supplier's current carbon footprint and its commitment to reducing emissions to achieve Net Zero emissions by 2050.

The CRP should be specific to the bidding entity, or, provided certain criteria are met, may cover the bidding entity and its parent organisation. In order to ensure the CRP remains relevant, a Carbon Reduction Plan covering the bidding entity and its parent organisation is only permissible where the detailed requirements of the CRP are met in full, as set out in the Technical Standard² and Guidance³, and all of the following criteria are met:

- The bidding entity is wholly owned by the parent;
- The commitment to achieving net zero by 2050 for UK operations is set out in the CRP for the parent and is supported and adopted by the bidding entity, demonstrated by the inclusion in the CRP of a statement that this will apply to the bidding entity;
- The environmental measures set out are stated to be able to be applied by the bidding entity when performing the relevant contract; and
- The CRP is published on the bidding entity's website.

Bidding entities must take steps to ensure they have their own CRP as soon as reasonably practicable and should note that the ability to rely on a parent organisation's Carbon Reduction Plan may only be a temporary measure under this selection criterion.

The Carbon Reduction Plan should be updated regularly (at least annually) and published and clearly signposted on the supplier's UK website. It should be approved by a director (or equivalent senior leadership) within the supplier's organisation to demonstrate a clear commitment to emissions reduction at the highest level. Suppliers may wish to adopt the key objectives of the Carbon Reduction Plan within their strategic plans. A template for the Carbon Reduction Plan is set out below. Please complete and publish your Carbon Reduction Plan in accordance with the reporting standard published alongside this PPN.

¹Bidding supplier or 'bidding entity' means the organisation with whom the contracting authority will enter into a contract if it is successful.

Emissions reduction targets

DBD Limited is committed to ensuring that our environmental impact is continually reviewed, minimised and, where possible, reduced.

The reporting period has seen continued growth across the business, including an increase in employee numbers and associated business activities. As a knowledge-based consultancy, DBD's principal sources of emissions continue to be business travel and office electricity consumption. Whilst total emissions have increased modestly during the reporting period, the organisation remains focused on reducing emissions intensity on a per employee basis through the adoption of flexible working arrangements, increased use of remote collaboration technologies and the promotion of lower carbon travel options where practicable.

DBD's business model remains one of sustainable growth, with knowledge-based services forming our core offering. As we continue to expand, our objectives are to:

- Minimise the ratio of carbon emitted per employee.
- Minimise total carbon emissions where reasonably practicable.
- Support our clients in achieving their own carbon reduction and Net Zero ambitions.

We remain committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2030 and will continue to review and implement measures that support the reduction of our environmental impact across all areas of the business.

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.
